Since September 2018, the Council of Catholic Women has been hosting a nightly Rosary call for the healing of the Church and for participants' personal intentions.

We believe that prayer is the foundation of action.

Our Lady of the Rosary

The month of October is dedicated to the Holy Rosary, one of the best known of all Catholic devotions. October includes the Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary (October 7). It was instituted to honor the Blessed Virgin Mary in gratitude for the protection that she gives the Church in answer to the praying of the Rosary by the faithful.

The great power of the Rosary became known throughout Christendom. Our Lady appeared before Domingo de Guzman (St. Dominic) and taught him the complete Rosary prayer, urging him to preach it to the world as remedy against sin. Saint Louis De Montfort once wrote: "The Rosary is the most powerful weapon to touch the Heart of Jesus, Our Redeemer, who loves His Mother."

On October 13, 1917, Our Lady appeared before three shepherd children in Fatima, Portugal. When asked her name, the Blessed Mother said: "I am the Lady of the Rosary." At Fatima, Our Lady taught us to pray the Rosary every day. Mary dispenses special graces, blessings, and protection to those who are devoted to the Rosary.

May the Rosary inspire us to honor Mary's living memory, to learn from her example, and to embody her spirit. Amen
